Armed Forces:

People in the armed forces have to go through vigorous training to be prepared for when and if you get sent somewhere. Some bad things about being in the armed forces is that you have to spend very long periods of time away from home, but some good things is that you can travel all over the world and meet new people. You're earning range from \$1,203-\$13,695 it doesn't pay a lot but you get to go to college for free. There are ten different jobs in the armed forces from health care to engineering.



Police and Detectives:

To be a police or detective it can be very stressful on your life because you have to deal with criminals and leave your home in short notice. There are seven different types of occupations you can do with this job a few are correctional officer, state police officers, Detectives, Sheriffs, and fish and game warden. The average amount of time you would put in a week is 40 hours. The typical working conditions are outdoors and through all kinds of weather. The average yearly earnings are \$44,160-\$99,698. To be in this you at least have to have a high school diploma to one to two years of college. This field of work is growing by 11% each year.

Aircraft pilots and Flight engineers:

There are four different occupations in this career. They are co pilots, captains, flight engineers and airline pilots. To be an aircraft or flight engineer you at least have to have college degree. The normal hour per month is 100 hours, and your average yearly salary is \$84,000-\$117,000. The down side to this is you have to spend a long time away from home, and there are unsafe flying conditions. To qualify for FAA licensure, applicants must be at least 18 years old and have at least 250 hours of flight experience.
